Additional Tasks

DETAILS

The Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Scholarship is awarded annually to high school seniors and college students who are junior members of the DSC and/or the children or grandchildren of voting members in good standing with a minimum of two years membership in the DSC.

Application Scoring: (This is for reviewers and can be easily changed before the Review Committee Meeting)

- Academic work 30%
- Personal essay 25%
- Second essay (Conservation, American History, or Second Amendment Rights) 25%
- Applicant appraisal form 20%

QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior (includes Middle College and 5th/13th year students) or current college student.
- Applicant must be a junior member of the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress and/or the child/grandchild of voting members in good standing with a minimum of two years membership.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Essay 1: Submit a personal statement describing your character, aspirations, education, career objectives, and future goals. If not explained elsewhere, include any comments concerning your personal situation which may be helpful to the Selection Committee as they evaluate your application. (350-550 words)

Essay 2: Submit an essay discussing one of the following: (350-550 words)

- Prompt A: Conservation
- Prompt B: Second Amendment Rights
- Prompt C: Any American Heritage /History topic from 1776-1976

APPLICANT APPRAISAL: This is an email sent from the application site on behalf of the student. The appraisal is returned directly to the application site.

Instructions for Applicant

Enter the name and email address of a person who will provide an appraisal on your behalf for the DSC Scholarship.

This appraisal should be completed by a high school teacher or college professor. The person may not be your parent, guardian, or other close relative.

Be sure to talk to the recipient in person so they know to look for the email. They may have to check junk/spam folder for your request.

Message from Applicant to Recipient

I am applying for the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Scholarship through Four County Community Foundation.

The scholarship requires an appraisal to help the Selection Committee review and score my application. The appraisal is due by March 1. Thank you in advance for your assistance.

Instructions for Recipient

The student named above is applying for a scholarship and has asked you to provide Four County Community Foundation information you feel would be helpful in reviewing his/her application.

The information you furnish is important to us. You may be assured that it will be considered confidential. Only applications that have the required recommendations on file will be considered. Submit the form before the due date of March 1.

Applicant Appraisal Form

- State your title and place of employment. What is your relationship to the applicant?
- How long and how well do you know the applicant?
- Does the applicant have the ability, determination, and discipline to complete his/her educational objective?
- Comment on the applicant's personal traits: cooperation, perseverance, character, work habits, ability to set realistic goals, commitment to educational goals, and commitment to the community.
