

Sporting Clays Covid-19 Prevention Best Practices

Sporting Clays opening TBD

All Covid-19 prevention best practices will be adhered to that are in effect the day the range is used. All Range Officers are to wear masks and gloves along with the use of hand sanitizer.

1. Sporting Clays when opened will be for DSC Members and Guests who must sign the DSC waiver form.
2. Sporting Clays will be accessible only through the side building window facing 5-Stand. Customers will follow the roped one-way walkway to the side of the building and exit using the path designated by the signs.
3. These rules will be posted at the customer entrance and on all doors.
4. There is no other access to the building.
5. Let the cashier know the number of rounds you and your squad wish to shoot. We will not be loaning any equipment, pouches, glasses or ear muffs. Also there will be no clipboards or pencils issued.
6. Ammo, ear plugs, glasses and reloading supplies will be available for purchase from the cashier.
7. We have installed a plexiglass shield, like many other businesses, and customers must interact with the cashier through this window only.
8. Squads will be issued sanitizing wipes in baggies and small bottles of hand sanitizer to clean the controller card and surfaces as you move through the course. However, we ask that you bring your own gloves, disinfectant, masks and whatever else you deem necessary to protect yourself and squad mates. You are participating in an outdoor activity at your own risk due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
9. Carts will be issued but no more than 2 shooters per cart and while in the cart masks are required. Carts will be disinfected after each use.
10. Masks on the field are optional but Social Distancing “MUST STRICTLY” be observed! All squad members must be 6 feet apart. The puller cords extend to at least 6 feet for distancing purposes.
11. Bonafide family members may be within the 6 feet limit only while interacting with each other. Examples are parents teaching junior shooters, or those assisting handicap shooters. At all other times, please observe the 6 feet distancing requirement.

12. Upon completion of your rounds, the member will return the controller card for cleaning and disinfecting along with the sanitizer bottle to be cleaned and refilled.
13. Absolutely “NO” gathering outside the building.
14. The inside restrooms are not available for use. Port-A-Potties will be available and will be sanitized regularly during the day.
15. We will be sanitizing exposed surfaces including the clays controller cards, card reader, puller controller, door handles, and carts on a regular basis throughout the day.
16. The Range Officer has complete authority on rules violations! All such violations will be documented on an incident report filed with the DSC Office. The first violation of any of the rules is a warning from the Range Officer, any subsequent violation you and your entire squad will be required to leave the premises without reimbursement and an incident report filed with the DSC Office. The DSC BOD will act on all such incident reports.
