## MASKING GUIDELINES MAY 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021



## Indoor/Outdoor face mask requirements.

Except for those identified below, all persons participating in activities at the DSC are required to wear a face mask.

The DSC has made a good faith effort to ensure that all persons visiting our facilities in Utica or in Oxford (including employees) comply with section 6(a) of the **05/15/21 MDHHS COVID Order.** For purposes of this section, the DSC has posted signs at all our venues and buildings open to the public, notifying visitors that wearing a mask is required unless a person falls into a specified exception. DSC Staff, Range Officers or other individuals in control of one or more venues may ask visitors not wearing masks whether they fall into a specified exception. The DSC also reserves the right to require face masks of all patrons and employees on any of its venues. This policy is designed to ensure compliance with section 6(a) of **MDHHS COVID Order dated 05/15/2021**.

## **Exceptions to face mask requirement.**

The requirement to wear a face mask does not apply to individuals who:

- 1. Are fully vaccinated persons;
- 2. Are younger than 2 years old;
- 3. Cannot medically tolerate a face mask;
- 4. Are eating or drinking while seated in a designated area or at a private residence;
- 5. Are swimming;
- 6. Are receiving a medical or personal care service for which removal of the face mask is necessary;
- 7. Are asked to temporarily remove a face mask for identification purposes;
- 8. Are communicating with someone who is deaf, deafblind, or hard of hearing and whose ability to see the mouth is essential to communication;
- 9. Are actively engaged in a public safety role, including but not limited to law enforcement, firefighters, or emergency medical personnel, and where wearing a face mask would seriously interfere in the performance of their public safety responsibilities;
- 10. Are engaging in a religious service;
- 11. Are giving a speech for broadcast or to an audience, provided that the audience is at least 12 feet away from the speaker; or
- 12. Are engaging in an activity that requires removal of a mask not listed in another part of this section, and are in a facility that provides ventilation that meets or exceeds 60 ft<sup>3</sup>/min of outdoor airflow per person.
