That includes nominating yourself for a position.

- Finally, the election committee will do the rest by checking that member's eligibility, confirming their interest to have their name placed on the ballot, and running the election.

Easy right!?!?

The election committee will be putting together the initial slate of nominees for the open positions before the September General Membership Meeting. All members nominated from the floor at the September General Membership Meeting, Sept. 2, will also be added to the list. Any DSC voting member who has been a member for at least one year by Sept. 2, 2020 and whose membership is in good standing, is eligible to run for one of the open director or trustee positions. A candidate may be nominated for more than one position, however, he or she

may only accept and appear on the ballot for one office in any one election.

Nominee letters will go out Sept. 3, 2020 and nominees will have until close of business Sept. 11, 2020 to notify the office in writing of their acceptance. Nominees that fail to notify the office within the specified time frame of their intention will be presumed to have refused the nomination, and their name will be removed from the list of eligible candidates.

If anyone has any election related questions or would like to be nominated or nominate another member for an open position, please send me an email or get in touch with the DSC office on, or before the Sept. 2 General Membership Meeting.

We did not have a chance to have a Highpower clinic this year. Do not let that deter you from coming out. If you show up, the regulars will help you learn the ropes.

Smallbore silhouette is shooting Tuesday and Saturday evenings. This league is challenging, fun and provides immediate feedback that is quite satisfying as you see the target fall and not just a little bitty hole in the paper.

The new tactical prone league is also progressing. It is shot from the prone position at 200 yards. Just about any equipment is allowed. The top shooters nary drop a point and the winner for the league will likely be the one with the most Xs, see more details at the DSC website.

Hold the presses!! The Easter Egg shoot is back! Tuesday Sept. 8 starting at

4:30 p.m. and going until all shooters get a chance or it gets dark – whichever comes first. This shoot is open to both members and the public. The targets are 6-hard-boiled chicken eggs hung at 200 yards. Your task is to hit them using a rifle (generally, scoped centerfire fires) in the prone position. There is an award for least number of shots and for least amount of time to hit all six eggs. In the Junior division, .22 rimfire rifles are used and shot at 50 yards.

This is one of the most popular special shoots that the DSC holds annually. It is nice that we can bring it back for 2020 in spite of COVID-19 The cost is \$10. There is an additional \$5 charge if you want a shot for the prize money. Note, that there is no prize for best decorated eggs this time. However, if the mood strikes you, there is no penalty for decoration either. Let's see what you bring!
