## Rifle

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## Famous Outlaws & Lawmen of the Old West: ***“Butch Cassidy & The Sundance Kid”***


It was one of the most famous endings in film history. In the 1969 movie *Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid*, the two outlaws, played by Paul Newman and Robert Redford appear to go out in a blaze of glory during a gun battle in Bolivia in 1908. **The film’s ambiguous ending points to a murkier truth. Many, including members of Cassidy’s family, believe that the real-life Butch Cassidy, the jovial, charismatic leader of the Wild Bunch, lived for decades after the legendary South American shootout.**

Butch and Sundance were members of the notorious Wild Bunch Gang. Robert Leroy Parker was born in 1866. His famous alias- **“Butch Cassidy”**-

resulted from a job in a butcher shop and his admiration for cattle rustler Mike Cassidy. Butch’s closest friend was Harry Alonzo Longbaugh. While still a teenager, Longbaugh was jailed in Sundance, Wyoming. Inevitably, he was nicknamed **“The Sundance Kid”**. Along the outlaw trail, he acquired a pretty mistress named *Etta Place*.

In 1901 the two outlaws and Etta Place fled to South America, where Butch and Sundance were apparently killed in 1908 in a gun battle in Bolivia.


