# Rifle

Sight In Season is now over and it was good year in spite of the scarcity of ammo. We are now back to our usual winter hours for open shooting — Sundays, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. The next special event is the annual Christmas cookie shoot, Sunday Dec. 18. For details, see the flyer on the "Coming Events page of the DSC website or in this issue of the P&K. The annual Rifle banquet is Dec. 3. League winners will be announced.

The Tactical Prone league had 12 shooters compete, with 7 shooters completing the 10-match course of fire for high power and 4 shooters did so for the 22 rimfire league. The overall high-power winner was Larry Remsynder with a score of 2000-139x. Rick Nowicke won the "Highest X Count" and finished second (2000-120x). High single match award went to Gary Dawson with a 200-15x. Larry Remsynder won the 22RF league with a 1914-53x.

In High Power League competition, we had 16 shooters compete and 12 completed the 10 required matches. The Grand Champion was Rick Nowicke with an average score of 491.7. The position champions are; Standing – Jim Parson (486.6-146x), Sitting – John Calabria (481.6-121x), Rapid Prone – Larry Remsynder (472.8-111x), and Slow Prone – Gary Dawson (476.5-96x) The Highest Single Match award went to Larry Frey (493-16x) The Lewis Class award winners were Matt Dering for Class A, and Stan Surratt for Class B.

# **Black Powder**

The recent shortages on shooting materials has me thinking of the various black powder shooting components again. I mostly shoot 50 cal. round balls. Traditionally, I have shot Speer Round balls. This for no particular reason except that they were what one could easily find at most muzzleloading supply houses or big box stores. Then they dried up for about 18 months. I was forced to look for other sources. I was given some cast balls and used them for some time. They shot well. I really couldn't tell much difference except that every once in a while, there would be a ball that was hard to start or gave a an unexplained flyer. For a while, casting seemed the way to go. Recently, I saw the Speer balls on sale, so I bought them. I was interested so I compared them to the cast balls. Well, there is no doubt about it, the swaged balls are more uniform in size and weight. I guess I shouldn't be surprised by this, and one should not read into this that swaged round balls are better than cast. First, cast round balls are dirt cheap and you never have to worry about running out of them. But to get the maximum accuracy, you do need to do some work. It would pay dividends to separate the cast balls by size and weight. Those outside the averages should not be used but simply recast. In that way, it is unlikely that you will be able to see a difference between cast ball and swagged ball performance. There is a parallel in modern rifle shooting. Top service rifle shooters frequently weight the bullets they use for the 600-yard line. It's the same thing.

Sunday, Nov. 13 was the Monthly Black Powder Woods Walk. It was a cold grey overcast day with spitting snow flurries. Four Shooters participated for this 15-shot event. Everyone else must have been over at rifle getting ready for the firearm deer season. The participants had a good time. The author made bean soup for lunch and we finished it off. The next BP woods walk is Dec. 11.
