Starting Times:	Practice at \approx 9 a.m., 1 st Match at \approx 10:30 a.m. each day.	
Course of Fire:	There will be two 40 shot matches each day with a short break between matches.	
Rules:	Current NRA Silhouette rules will apply. DSC Rifle Range Rules will apply.	
Classification:	The NRA classifications will be used. Local classification books may be honored at the discretion of the Match Director.	
Registration:	These are squadded matches. Pre-registration is recommended, but not required. Squadding requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis. Late entries will be accepted only if they do not require special squadding or additional relays. Entries will close at 9:30 a.m. each day.	
Entry Fees:	\$30 per competitor. Second rifle: \$15 Juniors \$10 & \$5	
Awards:	Awards will be based on the 80 shot aggregate scores. Awards will be for Match Winner and first in each class; however, if fewer than 5 entries in Master class, they will compete for Match Winner only. Additional class awards will be based on one award per 5 entries (i.e., 2 awards for 6-10 entries, etc.). Other awards may be presented per Match Director's bulletin based on pre-registration entries.

It is the competitor's responsibility to see that ejected cases do not interfere with other competitors. Rule 9.3 – Case Deflector. Empty chamber indicators will be utilized.
