



.22 Steel Practice Wednesday 6pm to Dusk Outdoor Pistol Range

Overview

The outdoor pistol range is open on Wednesdays from 6:00 PM to dusk. This session is available to both **DSC members, non-members and Junior shooters at open shooting rates**. We permit .22 rimfire pistols and .22 rimfire rifles with box magazines. Each course of fire is limited to 10 rounds per magazine; no magazine changes are permitted during the course of fire.

Summary

- **Setup:** Five metal targets will be positioned in various alignments **Minimum 10 yards** from the firing line.
- **Course of Fire:** Firearms must be brought cased and unloaded to shooting box. Magazines should be pre-loaded with 10 rounds of .22 caliber lead ammunition and will be loaded at a specific table.
- **Procedure:** Once in the shooting box, the Range Officer (RO) will give the command to "Load and Make Ready." Muzzles must remain pointed toward the backstop at all times.
- **Timing:** The RO will signal when the shooter is ready and trigger a shot timer. Shooters must double-tap each target. The timer stops once all targets have been hit twice.
- **Scoring:** If a shooter fails to hit each target twice within the time limit, the timer will be stopped at 10th round and 5 seconds will be added for each round were target is missed.
- **Malfunctions:** If a malfunction occurs, the shooter must clear the firearm and will be allowed to repeat the course of fire with a new magazine.
