Learn how to be a safe hunter and earn your certificate. Class taught by state certified hunter education instructors. Class is mandatory to purchase a Michigan hunting license for those born on or after Jan. 1, 1960.

We offer **two separate classes** that run during the weekend. **ONLINE REGISTRATION O TRADITIONAL CLASS PART 1**: Saturday: Check in 7:30 a.m. ~ Class is 8 a.m. – 3 p.m. **TRADITIONAL CLASS PART 2**: Sunday: Check in 7:30 a.m. ~ Class 8 a.m. – Noon. **FIELD DAY CLASS**: Sunday: Check in 12:30 p.m. ~ Class 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.

The <u>FIELD DAY CLASS</u> is only for students who have completed the **ONLINE HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE** <u>OR</u> completed all review questions in the "Today's Hunter" booklet. At check-in, the online course certificate (paper or phone picture) <u>OR</u> the completed review questions must be presented.

Saturday - Lecture, demonstrations, hunting regulations. **Sunday** - Test review, test, firearm handling, compass training plus shotgun and rifle shooting. Morning or afternoon edition is the same program.

Registration is online at the Michigan DNR website only, **NOT** at the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress. Register at: Michigan DNR website (under education), https://michigan.storefront.kalkomey.com/em/programs or use **QR code** above and search by class type (traditional or field), date and for the Detroit Sportsmen's Congress class. Register for one class only.

You can view the **TRADITIONAL CLASS** and **FIELD DAY CLASS** details Aug. 4 with registration opening Aug. 18. Once a class is full, the system will remove it from view on the web site. Student cancellations will reopen the class and restore viewing and registration options. So check back often if you try to register and find the class full.

Parents & Grandparents, without a certificate, are encouraged to enroll.
