

DETROIT SPORTSMEN'S CONGRESS CMP SERVICE RIFLE CLINIC & MATCH



Presented by the Education & Rifle Committees

May 1 & 3, 2025

The purpose of this clinic is to provide instruction and training for the new shooter in Service Rifle competition. Emphasis placed on positions, rules, competition and match operations. Clinic is open to any US citizen 14-years or older with a maximum number of 20-students. Instruction provided by certified CMP Garand Master Instructors and NRA rifle instructors, who are also competitive rifle shooters. Additionally the DSC offers a yearly service rifle league. This will allow you to apply what you have learned and continue to improve your marksmanship.

Entry fees include all class material, match, ammunition fees and the use of a rifle. Due to range capacity and course materials, we require a non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for this clinic and match.

Deposits must be received on or before 25 April 2025, entries received after this date will be placed on stand-by.

CLINIC: Thursday May 1, 2025 (6:30 – 9:30 p.m. approximately ~ Clubhouse)

Saturday May 3, 2025 (9 – 11:30 a.m. ~ Clubhouse)

Classroom with a hands-on practical exercises (using Garands and AR-15's)

MATCH: Saturday May 3, 2025 (12:30 to 4:30 p.m. approximately ~.Rifle Range)

Practical exercises (using Garands and AR-15's followed by the match.

50-round approved CMP Match. Ammunition is included.

MATCH IS OPEN ONLY TO THOSE STUDENTS ATTENDING THIS CLINIC

FEES: Non-member: \$150 DSC member: \$100 Non-member Junior*: \$75 DSC Junior*: \$60.

Includes clinic and match. You may join the club to receive the member rates.

Optional memberships (Jan. – Dec.): DSC Junior membership \$25/year (\$10 net cost) Junior members have full club privileges to all venues. Plus can participate in junior archery, pistol, rifle and shotgun. Adult memberships have many variations, please inquire if you are interested. Call the DSC office: 586-739-3500 and mention you are attending the clinic.

Memberships are prorated. Please include a membership application if joining.

RIFLES: Rifles and ammo provided, M1 Garands and AR-15. Students with an AR-15 or M1 Garand

rifle may use them in the match provided they pass a safety inspection. AR-15s can be

configured multiple ways and most will not be set-up for service rifle competition.

MATCH RULES: Current "CMP Service Rifle" rules. Competitors are required to score targets. Target scoring

will be on the frame. Eye and ear protection required for competitors and spectators on the line (available). Free copy of the CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules in pdf format:

Additionally, the CMP Games Rifle & Pistol Competition Rules are also available and covers the rules for Garand and Vintage Military Rifle match rules. **All must sign CMP waiver.**

COURSE OF FIRE: As-Issued Military Rifle Course "B". 55-rounds (included) at 200-yards (SR Target).

Sighters: 5-shots ~ 10-minutes ~ any position

Phase 1: Slow fire prone position

20-shots ~ 20-minutes

Phase 2: Rapid fire standing to prone position

10-shots ~ 70-seconds

Phase 3: Rapid fire standing to sitting position

10-shots ~ 60-seconds

Phase 4: Slow fire standing position

10-shots ~ 10-minutes

Notes: Three-minute preparation periods provided for the rapid-fire phases.

For slow fire, any block times will be at the discretion of the chief range officer.
