## DSC Hosts Jr. Rifle Sectional

DSC hosted the 2022 NRA Junior Rifle Local Sectional Matches Feb. 27. Sectionals are national matches held at local ranges across the country. The sectional events included 4 Position Conventional and 3 Position Metric in the smallbore events and Air Rifle Standing and 3 Position Precision in the air rifle events. Although the Covid-related shut-downs hit the Michigan Junior Rifle Programs hard over the past years, a strong contingent of Ohio athletes helped fill our ranks.

DSC is rebuilding its junior team and did not field enough members to meet the team event requirements, but had some strong showings in the individual standings. DSC's Steven Bethell, Thomas McCourt and Henry McCourt swept the 4 Position event with our newest expert, Steven Bethell, winning gold in the 4 Position smallbore and silver in the 3 Position Precision Air Rifle event. The American Legion Post 295 Junior Rifle Team won the 3 Position Metric and Air Rifle Standing team events.

The DSC Juniors will be back in action at the Civilian Marksmanship Program monthly Air Rifle Matches at Camp Perry, Ohio in April and look forward to hosting the Michigan Junior Outdoor Championship in May.

## **Detroit Sportsmen's Congress Annual Outdoor .22 Steel Pistol Matches – 2022**

# DSC 2022 Service Rifle Clinic & Match

The purpose of this clinic is to provide instruction and training for the Service Rifle competition new shooter. Emphasis placed on positions, rules, competition and match operations. Clinic is open to any US citizen 14 years or older with a maximum number of 40 students. Instruction provided by certified CMP Garand master instructors and NRA rifle instructors, who are also competitive rifle shooters. The DSC offers a yearly service rifle league. This will allow you to apply what you have learned and continue to improve your marksmanship.

Entry fees include all class material, match, ammunition fees and the use of a rifle. Due to range capacity and course materials, we require a non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for this clinic and match.

Deposits must be received before **20 April 2022**, entries received after this date will be placed on stand-by. Confirmations by email unless you include a self-addressed post card with your entry.

**CLINIC:** FRI. 29 April 2022 ( 6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. approx.~ Clubhouse) SAT. 30 April 2022 ( 9:00 a.m. – noon ~ Clubhouse)

**MATCH:** SAT. 30 April 2022 (1 to 6 p.m. ~ Rifle Range) Practical exercises (using Garands and AR-15s followed by the match at 3 p.m.)  
50-round approved CMP Match. MATCH IS OPEN ONLY TO THOSE STUDENTS ATTENDING THIS CLINIC

**FEES:** Non-member \$100, DSC member \$70 and junior 14-18 \$40. Fee includes clinic and match. Ammo is included.

**TIME:** Competitors **must attend** a mandatory squadding and safety meeting at approximately 3 p.m.

**RIFLES:** Rifles and ammo provided, M1 Garands and some AR-15s.  
Students with an AR-15 or M1 Garand rifle may use them in the match provided they pass a safety inspection.

**RULES:** Current "CMP Service rifle" rules. Competitors are required to score targets. Target scoring will be on the frame. Eye and ear protection required for competitors and spectators on the line (available). **COURSE OF FIRE:** Fifty rounds plus sighters at 200-yards. Ammo included.

**Sighters:** 5-shots ~ 10-minutes ~ any position

**Phase 3:** Rapid fire standing to prone posit. ~ 10 shots ~ 70-seconds  
(SR-42 — 300-yd reduced target)

**Phase 1:** Slow fire standing position ~ 10-shots ~ 10-minutes  
(SR - 200-yd target)

**Phase 4:** Slow fire prone position ~ 20 shots ~ 20-minutes  
(MR-52 — 600-yd reduced target)

**Phase 2:** Rapid fire standing to sitting position ~ 10 shots ~ 60-seconds  
(SR - 200-yd target)

**Notes:** 3-minute prep periods for the rapid-fire phases. For slow fire, block times will be at the discretion of the chief range officer.

# Rifle

Its April. It's time to get ready for the outdoor season and leagues. There are three rifle events of significance this April. The first is that perennial favorite, the Annual Easter Egg Shoot, to be held Saturday, April 16. Bring six decorated hard-boiled eggs and you get a chance to shoot at them at 200 yards. Shooting is from the prone position. There are three prize categories; least time to shoot all six eggs, least number of rounds fired to shoot all six eggs and best of all, best decorated eggs. Every year, this last category becomes more competitive as participants show their creativity in egg decoration. This combined with the difficulty in shooting an egg-size target at 200 yards adds up to a lot of fun for contestants and participants alike. Registration begins at 9 a.m., the egg judgement begins at 9:30 and the shooting event begins at 10 a.m.

The annual rifle range workbee, to prepare the range for the season, will be held Saturday, April 23 from 8:30 a.m.-noon. We will clean out and organize the range building and storage sheds and basically do whatever is necessary to get the range ready for the upcoming summer season and leagues. We will also work on servicing the highpower targets. This includes making new frames or frame backers, pasting new SR targets to cardboard and cleaning out and organizing the 200-yard storage shed. If you need work

hours, this is a great opportunity. A special project this year will be to dig out and repair the silhouette frames and rebury them.

Following the workbee is the annual Marine Corps League Annual Fun Shoot. You do not have to be a Marine or former Marine to participate.

The DSC will host a Civilian Marksmanship Program-based high power clinic and match, April 29 & 30. If you have any interest in high power shooting but don't know much about it, this clinic is a good place to see if it's something you would like to try. It will cover what equipment is used, how it is used, how to shoot in position and how a high power match works. Then, you will get to practice what you have learned as a participant in an actual high power match. The two main instructors are Corey Salo and Jim Rhodes. Both are very knowledgeable about position shooting and high power. In addition, you will get one-on-one instruction from a cadre of actual high power shooters. They will also be there to coach you through the match. You will learn a lot.

Reminder the rifle leagues start in May. Make your plans now to participate and try something new. League registration forms are now available.

Five shooters braved the weather. The neat thing was that they all brought flintlocks. Even more impressive was the consistency of ignition. There were no failures to fire because of the damp or wet. Indeed, there were remarkably few misfires. No one needed more than three hammer falls. For the most part, the flintlocks went bang every time. I don't think that cap locks would have done much better - If your flint gets wet, wipe it dry and go. If your caps get wet, you're toast. The author finished first shooting his Golden Age 40 caliber flintlock rifle with a score of 12. Marty Grennier finished second with 11 hits using his trade gun. That's fine shooting. Lunch was bean soup which tasted good on a cold day.

The next black powder woods walk is April 10. Hope you can make it out to shoot or just watch.
